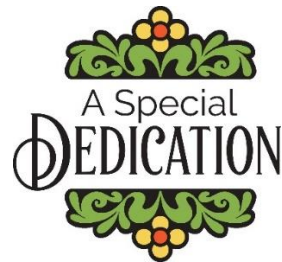

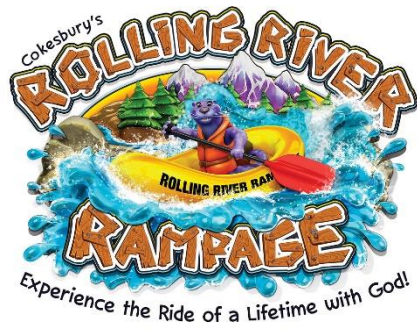

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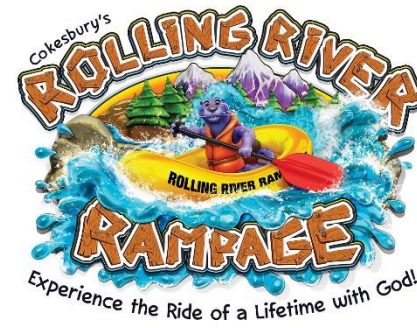
Save the date! Vacation Bible School is **July 23-25** for ages Pre-K through 6th grade. Join us for all the fun!
